The Ghana Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) Platform on the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and Media Foundation for West Africa (MFWA) in partnership with Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH are pleased to announce a training workshop for media personnel on **June 18, 2020**.

The purpose of the workshop is to equip participants with the professional skills and ethical discipline needed for covering and communicating the COVID-19 pandemic. The training will address issues of: ethical reporting, understanding and interpreting Covid-19 related data and public health concepts, identifying and addressing fake news, and staying safe while reporting under COVID-19 conditions. There will be a half-day follow-up training session on **July 9**, **2020** to address questions and gaps identified during Covid-19 related reporting after the workshop.

- \* Willing to participate in a virtual (online) training session
